STD and JWW Master/Excellent classes may have split walk-throughs, depending on final entry numbers. FAST classes may run combined, depending on final entry numbers.

Entry fees include a \$3.50 per run fee to AKC for the first entry per day and \$3.00 for each additional entry per day.

Paper Entries: Make checks payable to STAC. Mail entry form(s) and fees to Shawn Cossart, 200 Gant Road, Dripping Springs, TX 78620. No entries will be accepted by phone or fax. Express mail entries must include the signature waiver allowing them to be left at the secretary's address. Inquiries may be directed to Shawn Cossart at <u>hotdogsports@gmail.com</u>. No entry shall be made, and no entry shall be accepted, which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Online Entries: This trial is accepting online entries through <u>www.labtestedonline.com</u>. During the first 48 hours after opening, the initial limit of entries designated as either online or paper will be as follows: 165 runs online (50%), 165 runs paper (50%) each day. If either form of entry has not filled at the end of the 48-hour time period, the club reserves the right to decrease or increase either one accordingly.

Exhibitors who wish to use the online entry service must create a user account at <u>www.labtestedonline.com</u> and add information for their dog(s). The initial 6-month use of this site is free. After that, there is a \$10 annual fee for continued use of the LabTestedOnline site. After setting up a user account, search by state for Texas and click on the "i" information icon to the right of the club's trial to create your entry.

Entering Mixed Heights or Mixed Classes: Separate entry forms must be submitted when the same dog is being entered in a mixture of Regular and Preferred classes and/or different jump heights within the same trial weekend thereby clearly indicating which class(es) and/or jump heights belong together for each trial day of the weekend. When calculating entry fees, treat multiple entry forms for the same dog as if only one form had been filled out. In other words, the 1st run entry fee is only paid once per day, per dog, even if that dog's runs have been submitted on multiple entry forms.

Confirmation of Receipt of Entry: An initial e-mail will be sent out as entries are processed. Move-ups are confirmed by a new emailed confirmation. If an exhibitor has multiple dogs entered, the updated email will only be for the dog that had the move-up. Final confirmations will go out after the trial has closed.

Change of Entry: Entry changes emailed to the Trial Secretary are not official until the exhibitor has received a return email confirmation from the Trial Secretary.

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor.

Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry. The Trial Secretary will add a **\$30.00** collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

SET-UP AND CHECK-IN

The site will be open for set-up at 9:00 am on Friday and at 7:00 am on Saturday and Sunday.

Check-in will be done via the AgilityGate app. Gate boards will not be used for check-in.

Judging will begin no earlier than 10:00 am on Friday and no earlier than 8:00 am on both Saturday and Sunday.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs 15 months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds. Bitches in season, dogs that are blind, and dogs that are taped or bandaged or in any way has anything attached to it for medical purposes are not eligible to participate.

FOR EXHIBITION ONLY & FIX AND GO ON

Entering For Exhibition Only (FEO)

FEO is allowed in all classes, all levels. Participation in FEO is non-qualifying. FEO course time is 45 seconds.

FEO runs are treated as trial entries. The exhibitor must enter the class(es) prior to the closing date, pay class entry fee(s) and the Trial Secretary must record the entry in the Trial Catalog as part of the results for that class.

FEO does not need to be noted on the entry form; the handler will declare the day of the show.

Dogs may be entered in any jump height for FEO runs. If entered in an ineligible jump height, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show jump height changes are not allowed.

Dogs may be entered in any level, in any class. If the dog is not eligible for the level entered, the team is committed to FEO for that run and must declare FEO on the start line. Day of show level changes are not allowed.

The exhibitor must declare FEO in the ring prior to leading out. FEO may be declared earlier (ex. when checking in at the gate board).

Toys are allowed in the ring

- o Toys must be non-audible o Toys may not leave the handler's hand
- o Toys that roll freely cannot be used

Food/Treats are not allowed in the ring

FEO should be utilized for the benefit of the dog and not as a punitive correction. Harsh verbal and /or physical corrections shall not be tolerated. Any determination of harshness by the judge shall be immediately whistled and the handler will be dismissed from the ring.

A judge must monitor the entire run. Judges can stop a run at any time.

Fix and Go On (FNG)

Fix and Go On is not pre-entered; rather, it occurs during the run.

FNG allows exhibitors to immediately reattempt an obstacle at any time while on course when the dog's performance of an obstacle is not to their expectation. This allows the dog to successfully complete the obstacle and then finish the course or leave the ring on a positive note. Using FNG will result in a non-qualifying score.

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, may be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or for any other reason.

JUMP HEIGHT CARDS & HEIGHT DIVISIONS

Measuring of Dogs: Jump height cards do not need to be submitted with the entry form. Indicate on the entry form whether the dog needs to be measured. If the dog needs to be measured, it is the handler's responsibility to ensure that the box on the entry form is checked and that the dog is measured prior to running. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct height division. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place indoors on a dirt surface. Ring size will be $90' \times 90'$.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Classes will have rosettes awarded to the 1st through 4th place in each jump height. Dogs must qualify to receive placement ribbons. Qualifying ribbons will be awarded to all dogs receiving qualifying scores. The first-place winner of each height in every class will be awarded a \$5 coupon that can be used toward a future entry in a Southeast Texas Agility Club trial. The coupon is valid for 3 years from the date of issue.

New: All Novice dogs will receive an entry gift, and all Novice dogs will receive a gift for placements!

MACH or PACH rosettes and bars will be awarded to those completing a MACH or PACH title. AGCH rosettes, corresponding dog neck collars, and bars will be awarded to those completing Agility Grand Champion titles. New Title rosettes will be awarded to those completing all other types of agility titles.

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Southeast Texas Agility Club (STAC) and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children. Southeast Texas Agility Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against Southeast Texas Agility Club or any official thereof.

All dogs must always be on leash when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. As such, the club will refund entry fees less \$10 per day of the entry fee paid for bitches unable to compete for this reason upon presentation of a veterinarian certificate. No bitches in season allowed in the show building.

RINGSIDE

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

Crating is available indoors. X-pens will not be allowed indoors. Be prepared to stack crates if needed. Crates may be left overnight at the show site; however, **Southeast Texas Agility Club** will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

The site is a private venue and dog friendly. Always secure all valuables.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement.

Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial or back-to-back trials only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running.
